



### **Planet Friendly Volunteer Events**

Location: Raglan Street, Town of Collingwood (CA)

Since 2013 (and most times on Earth Day), Greenland Group staff and families hold an annual clean-up of Raglan Street after it was reconstructed in 2011. It is now a gateway to the community's industrial park and includes the Georgian College campus.



### **First Nations Education Support**

Location: Munsee-Delaware First Nation (CA)

Since 2009, the Greenland Group (via Stragis Environmental) has provided in-kind/pro-bono support to community training and celebration events involving Indigenous Peoples. This includes teaching classes in association with the Anishinabek Educational Institute at Nipissing University in North Bay (CA).



### **Annual Charity Support**

Location: Town of Collingwood (CA)

For the past decade, the Greenland Group has coordinated (and sponsored) with Trinity United Church a youth Christmas Box campaign. Every year, many boxes with donated presents are wrapped/distributed by Greenland staff and for local families in need.



### **NGO Project Support**

Location: Ontario Water Centre (CA)

Since incorporation, the Greenland Group has provided in-kind and financial support to environmental Non-Government Organizations (NGOs). This includes a recent children's book prepared by the Ontario Water Centre about the Lake Simcoe Basin titled: *"Do Fish Fart? And Many More Amazing Questions and Answers about Lake Simcoe"*.



### **University Financial Support**

Location: University of Guelph Engineering School Expansion (CA)

Since 2003, the Greenland Group has maintained strong ties with Ontario-based universities involved with collaborative R&D and software development projects of mutual interest. This includes Guelph University and where Greenland directors financially supported a recent construction project.



### **Public – Private Partnerships**

Location: County of Simcoe (CA)

Since incorporation, the Greenland Group has maintained a unique public-private partnership business model to develop science-based technologies. This has included the Nottawasaga Valley Conservation Authority and other partners to secure funding for projects of mutual interest. ### **University Education Support**

Location: University of Guelph (CA) - Judging Panel for the School of Engineering Design Contest

Since 2003, the Greenland Group has maintained strong ties with Ontario-based universities involved with collaborative R&D and software development projects of mutual interest. This includes Guelph University where Greenland staff volunteer annually to support many Engineering School events.



### **National Charity Support**

Location: Canada

Since 2003, the Greenland Group has financially supported national registered charities operating across Canada.
